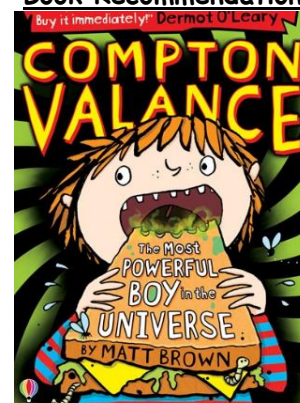
Class Snippet: Hedgehog Class
