A good attendance is considered to be 95% or over. For some parents, 90% may seem like an acceptable level of attendance, but the reality is that 90% attendance means that a child will miss half a school day each week or 19 days of school during the school year - that's nearly 4 school weeks

They were called Reverend Elaine Mundy and Ann Kerridge. We learnt that World War One started in 1914 and ended in 1918. Did you know that the war lasted for four years? We were allowed to touch a 100 year old newspaper and two genuine medals. Did you know that it was June's Dad and Grandad that fought in the war? Did you know that 84 people from Cardinham fought in the War but sadly 15 were killed and only 69 returned? We would like to say a huge thank you to our three visitors.

Remembrance Day Service



As you may be aware, on Sunday 11th November, it will mark the 100th year anniversary of the end of the 1st World War. On this day, there will be a remembrance service held in Cardinham. Crowds will gather at 10.50am by the War Memorial in the new graveyard at St. Meubred's Church where wreaths will be laid and a minutes silence observed. There will be a dedication of the WW1 Parish Memorial Stone in the churchyard then a short united service in the
