A community-led partnership supported by Cornwall Council is working on a proposal for west Cornwall to become an International Dark Sky Reserve. The partnership is keen to hear your views before they proceed with an application to the International Dark-Sky Association.

The main purpose of the designation is to protect the amazing quality of the dark night sky and it would be managed in a similar way to Bodmin Moor's International Dark Sky Landscape designation with a core area and a buffer zone to the east which would include Penzance and St Ives.
