Carol Randall (a resident in Bodmin) has recognised that there are many people who would like to come into town and visit shops and activities but can't because of the absence of accessible and affordable transport.

There are also groups, like Age Concern Bodmin, who would organise more activities if transport was available. Carol, along with Barry Cornelius & Andy Lyle, have been chatting with a number of people about how we might be able to make this happen. A very generous offer of help from Andy Lyle has given us an opportunity to run a Community Bus in Bodmin for a trial period of six months. When the trial period is completed satisfactorily and demand is proven to be sufficient to sustain costs, we can review the best way forward. First we have to assess whether there is sufficient demand to sustain a bus.
