His books, Rory Branagan (Detective), are a lead title of Harper Collins, just won the Waverton Award as Best Read of All Children's Books 2019 (a prize voted by a jury of primary school children from numerous schools). They've been sold round the world, and are in development as a new Netflix series.

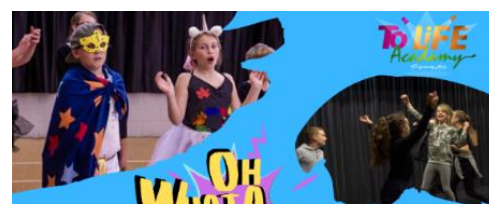
