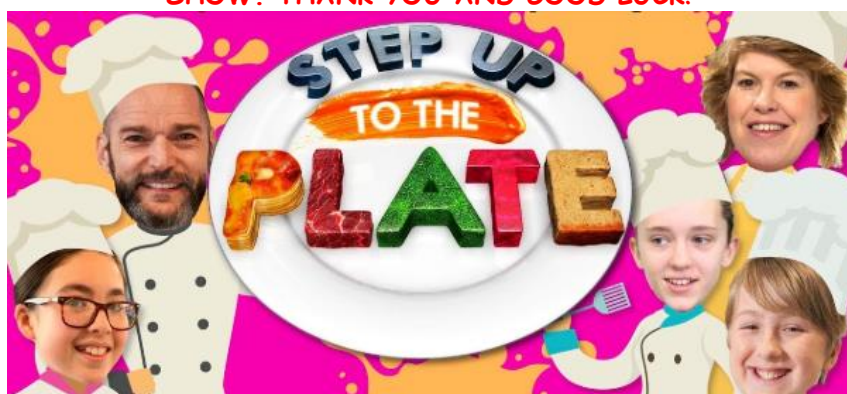

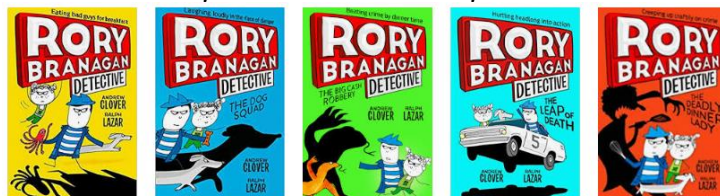

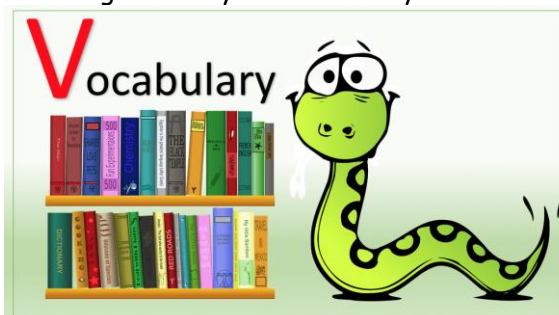


Weekly Reading VIPERS Challenge
