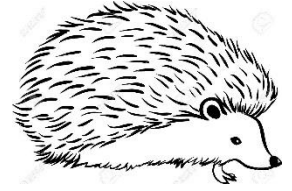


Hedgehog Class Newsletter

Phonics and Spellings

All children in Year 1 and Reception take part in a daily phonics session in the morning and children in Year 1 will continue to bring home spellings to learn once a week, ready for their weekly spelling test which will be on the following Thursday.

Maths

- Year 1 – We will be learning about addition and subtraction, place value, length, height, weight and volume this term.
- Reception – We will continue working on Numbers, Shape, Space and Measure this term.
- Nursery – We will continue working on Numbers, Shape, Space and Measure this term.

Physical Education

Jack from Plymouth Argyle will continue to lead our PE sessions for all children on a Thursday. PE takes place in all weathers so please ensure that your child has warm PE trousers, top and spare socks. Reception and Nursery children will have leap into life sessions throughout the week and Year 1 children will be have a dance session on a Wednesday afternoon.

We will continue to take part in the Daily Mile on the school field so please make sure your child has a pair of named wellies in school, these can be left on our welly wall in the playground.

Outdoor learning

All children in Reception and Nursery will continue to take part in outdoor learning every Wednesday afternoon this term. Please send your child to school in warm clothes that you don't mind them getting muddy as well as with their waterproof clothing. Year 1 children will have an outdoor learning session during the second half of this term and I will let you know the dates nearer to the time.
