Class Updates

As geographers we have been excited to learn about continents and oceans and as scientists we have been studying different types of animals around the world. As writers we have been learning the story of 'Monkey say, monkey do' and have written some exciting sentences to describe the monkeys and the hats. We are looking forward to writing our own version of the story over the next few weeks. As explorers in outdoor learning we have made clay prints of cow parsley and different types of grasses and we are looking forward to Sports Day.



As aspiring writers and artists, we loved coming back to school to find out what our next class story would be. Our new class story is 'The lion and the mouse'. Our first activity back after half term was to design and make two masks that we could use for our story telling drama techniques. We have discussed the class story together and now understand that the story comes from a moral fable. This means that the story teaches us a valuable lesson (Harry B Yr2). The children had lots of fun using the masks to help sequence the story. As Geographers, we are looking forward to finding out more about the United Kingdom.
