At Cardinham School, we value the Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural development of our pupils. To encourage further development in this area, we are delighted to introduce to you 'The Cardinham Challenge'.

This academic year, staff have devised 'The Cardinham Challenge'. The challenge encourages children to independently develop their Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural at home by completing a number of challenges. Children have a set amount of time to complete the challenges and are then awarded a Bronze, Silver or Gold award depending on their success and engagement with the challenge. Children must complete ALL challenges within Bronze to achieve a Bronze Award, ALL challenges within Silver to achieve a Silver Award and ALL challenges within Gold to achieve a Gold Award.

Our ambition is for 'The Cardinham Challenge' to grow and develop year on year. We hope that the format will also prepare children for secondary school when we hope they will embark on the adventures and challenges that the Duke of Edinburgh will bring them.
